

Life to Eagle Coordinator

Duties:

- Provide the official BSA *Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Workbook* at the Court of Honor for all Scouts attaining Life rank.
- Review workbook with Life scouts to ensure they understand the general process of attaining the Eagle rank.
- Advise Life scouts on Eagle service projects and provide guidance on paperwork preparation.
- Identify the district and council resources available to the Scout.
- Keep the Scout within the guidelines of the Guide to Safe Scouting, money earning project and other policies.
- Keep Scoutmaster abreast of Life Scout's progress towards Eagle
- Coordinate for the Eagle Board of Review
- Coordinate with Treasurer for purchase of the Eagle Award package
- Assist families of Eagle scouts with Eagle Court-of-Honor planning.
- Coordinate with Advancement Coordinator requests for Eagle letters of congratulations from dignitaries.
- Attend troop committee meetings to brief status of Life to Eagle Scouts.
